Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets, and blood gas test results. Dr. Richard Brown was the Commission Veterinarian for blood gas testing today.

FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:16 p.m.

#2, “So Kitten” was a vet scratch. **Inquiry concerning the stretch run.** The rider of #1, “Whateverybodywants” lodged an **objection** against the rider of #5, “Double Whammy” for alleged interference at the top of the stretch. After speaking with the jockeys involved and reviewing the video evidence, the Stewards determined that #5 caused interference when the rider allowed his horse to come in to the path and bump #1. #5, “Double Whammy” was disqualified from 3rd and placed 4th. #1, “Whateverybodywants” was moved up from 4th to 3rd place.

An all-inclusive test was requested by the claimant. We cancelled Show, Trifecta, Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below five betting interests.

After speaking with the jockeys involved and reviewing the video evidence, the Stewards determined that there was no reason for a disqualification.
