



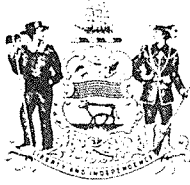
A report from Truesdail Laboratories, Inc., the official chemists of the Delaware Thoroughbred Racing Commission, showed that blood sample 23919, taken from the horse "Ranger's Coming", winner of the ninth (9th) race on October 2, 2019, was found to contain phenylbutazone in the amount of 3.7 +/- 0.3 micrograms/ml. The owner and trainer of this horse, Anthony J. Russo, DOB: 06/08/1957, RCI ID: 1969324, waived his right to a split sample.

Mr. Russo waived his right to a hearing, and under the authority of the Stewards, is fined the sum of five hundred dollars (\$500.00). Refer to D.T.R.C. Rules 3.4 and 15.1.1 Fine must be paid within 48 hours. (*Monetary fines not paid within the parameters of the official ruling are subject to penalty and interest charges at the rate of 1.5% per month compounded monthly*)




