Narrative:

Acting on a report from Truesdail Laboratories, Inc. the official testing laboratory for the Delaware Thoroughbred Racing Commission, that blood sample 27807 had exceeded the threshold limit "Dexamethasone" (20 +/- 2.5 pg/ml), a violation of D.T.R.C. Rule 15.1.3.1.1 and 15.18 which establishes a threshold of 5 pg/ml in blood. The Stewards at Delaware Park determined that blood sample 27807 was obtained from "Golden Can", First (1) place finisher of the seventh (7) race on September 16, 2020. The trainer of record for "Golden Can" was Hassan Elamri.

Trainer Hassan Elamri was notified of the results of the test on "Golden Can".

Trainer Hassan Elamri then waived his right to a split sample and hearing by Telephone on

11/13/2020, in the matter and agreed to the penalty established by the Uniform Classification Guidelines for Foreign Substances and Recommended Penalties as approved by the Delaware Thoroughbred Racing Commission in D.T.R.C. Rule 15.18

Based on the evidence available to them, the Stewards have determined the following: Hassan Elamri was the trainer of record for "Golden Can" on September 16, 2020 at the time "Dexamethasone" was found in the blood sample provided by "Golden Can" following the seventh race.

"Dexamethasone" is an allowable medication in Delaware not to exceed a level of 5 pg/ml of blood.

The report from Truesdail Laboratories, the primary laboratory of the D.T.R.C. indicated 20 +/- 2.5 pg/ml of "Dexamethasone" had been detected in the blood of "Golden Can".

Pursuant to D.T.R.C. Rule 7.3.1, 7.3.6 and 15.3.2. A registered Trainer shall bear primary responsibility for the proper care, health, training condition, safety and protection against administration of prohibited drugs or medication of horses in his charge.

The Stewards FIND Mr. Elamri in Violation of D.T.R.C. Rule 15.18 for testing in excess of the allowable limit of 5 pg/ml of blood for "Dexamethasone" in "Golden Can" in the seventh (7) race on September 16, 2020. "Dexamethasone" is a class "4" drug with a C penalty which has been established by the Uniform Classification Guideline for Foreign Substances and Recommended Penalties Model Rule.

Pursuant to the Guidelines noted above and the rules of the Delaware Thoroughbred Racing Commission, the Stewards hereby ORDER the following:

Trainer Hassan Elamri is fined \$1000;

"Golden Can" is disqualified from first place for the purpose of receiving purse money. Owner Hassan Elamri is ORDERED to return the purse money earned by "Golden Can" in that race to the Horseman's Bookkeeper, the purse money is to be redistributed as followed:

Under D.T.R.C. Rule 15.19, points are assigned to medication violations and Mr. Elamri is being assigned .05 penalty points for the Dexamethasone violation.

This ruling does not affect the pari-mutuel payoffs for this race.

Failure to pay the assessed fine by the due date may result in a suspension of license. Monetary fines not paid within the parameters of the official ruling are subject to penalty and interest charges at the rate of 1.5% per month compounded monthly.
